## 4. Examinee:

(1)The examinees for this test are the new master degree students of each department who enrolled in NCU in 2017. Students of In-Service Master Program and students of Industrial Technology R&D Master Program are not included. **If the freshman of graduate school already has the English certification and has reached the condition of the department (more information of the condition of the department, please check: [http://www.lc.ncu.edu.tw/main/chinese/graduation\\_105.php](http://www.lc.ncu.edu.tw/main/chinese/graduation_105.php)) There's no need to attend the exam. The freshman of graduate school should provide the certification to the department if he/she is qualified.**
