

Course Credit Waiver Guidelines for Doctoral Students in the Department of Business Administration at National Central University

Approved at the Departmental Affairs Committee Meeting on January 07, 2003
Appraised and ratified at the Academic Affairs Committee Meeting on March 27, 2003

- Article 1 These guidelines are provided in accordance with the *National Central University Credit Waiver Guidelines*.
- Article 2 Any credit hours earned from doctoral courses taken at National Central University or at other universities after the student completed his or her master's degree can be waived.
- Article 3 Students who have taken doctoral courses offered by the University while enrolled in the master's program may apply for a course credit waiver; in such cases, applications for course credit waivers are restricted to courses which have not previously been counted toward the student's minimum master's graduation requirements.
- Article 4 Students who wish to apply for a course credit waiver should do so during their first semester at the University; no more than two-thirds of the minimum number of earned credit hours required for graduation can be waived.
- Article 5 Applications for course credit waivers shall be reviewed and decided by the faculty of the specialty section to which the student belongs.
- Article 6 The aforementioned guidelines shall be implemented and entered into force upon approval by a meeting of the Departmental Affairs Committee and appraisal and ratification by a meeting of the Academic Affairs Committee. The same procedure applies to any amendment of these guidelines.
