

Course Credit Waiver Guidelines for Students in the Graduate Institute of Learning and Instruction at National Central University

Approved at the Institutional Affairs Committee Meeting on September 03, 2002
Appraised and ratified at the Academic Affairs Committee Meeting on December 19, 2002

- Article 1 These guidelines are provided in accordance with the *National Central University Credit Waiver Guidelines*.
- Article 2 Students who have received a grade of 70 or more for graduate courses offered by National Central University or some other university may apply for a course credit waiver; in such case, applications are restricted to courses which have not previously been counted toward the student's minimum baccalaureate graduation requirements; credit hours earned from courses which have previously been counted toward the student's minimum baccalaureate graduation requirements cannot be waived, but students who have taken such courses may apply for a course exemption.
- Article 3 Graduate students who have previously been enrolled in a graduate program in the University or at some other university may apply for a waiver of course credits provided they have received a grade point average of 70 points or more for the courses for which they are seeking a waiver.
- Article 4 Any course or credit hours waived must conform to the Institute's course and credit hour waiver policy.
- Article 5 A maximum of one-third of the credit hours required for graduation can be waived; students may not apply more than once.
- Article 6 The aforementioned guidelines shall be implemented and entered into force upon approval by a meeting of the Institutional Affairs Committee and appraisal and ratification by a meeting of the Academic Affairs Committee. The same procedure applies to any amendment of these guidelines.
