

Course Credit Waiver Guidelines for Master's Students in the Department of Mathematics at National Central University

Appraised and ratified at the Academic Affairs Committee Meeting on March 26, 2008

- Article 1 These guidelines are provided in accordance with the *National Central University Credit Waiver Guidelines*.
- Article 2 Students who wish to apply for a course credit waiver should do so within the deadline specified in the academic calendar of their first semester at the University or (in the case of transfer students) first semester in the program.
- Article 3 Students who have taken courses related to the basic or advanced courses prescribed by the graduate program prior to their admission into the University or graduate program and have received a semester grade 70 points or more may apply for a waiver of course credits.
- Article 4 Course credit waivers are subject to review by the Curriculum Committee.
- Article 5 There is no limit to the number of credit hours that can be waived, but students are required to take at least one credit hour of courses during their study at the University; grades earned from waived courses may not be included in the calculation of the student's semester or graduation grade point averages.
- Article 6 Matters not covered in these guidelines shall be conducted in accordance with the relevant rules and regulations of the Ministry of Education and of the University.
- Article 7 The aforementioned guidelines shall be implemented and entered into force upon approval by a meeting of the Departmental (Institutional) Affairs Committee and appraisal and ratification by a meeting of the Academic Affairs Committee. The same procedure applies to any amendment of these guidelines.
