

Course Credit Waiver Guidelines for Students in the Graduate Institute of Hakka Language and Literature at National Central University

Approved at the 3rd Institutional Affairs Committee Meeting on April 14, 2008
Appraised and ratified at the Academic Affairs Committee Meeting on June 11, 2008

- Article 1 These guidelines are provided in accordance with the *National Central University Credit Waiver Guidelines*.
- Article 2 Students who have taken relevant graduate courses offered by National Central University or by other universities within five years of their admission into the Institute and have obtained the approval of the Institute's Curriculum Committee may apply for a course credit waiver; the maximum number of course credit hours that can be waived is six.
- Article 3 Students who wish to apply for a course credit waiver should do so within the deadline as specified in the academic calendar of their first semester at the University; no students may apply for a waiver more than once.
- Article 4 Any course credit hours for courses which have previously been counted toward the student's minimum graduation requirements for a degree may not be waived.
- Article 5 Matters not covered in these guidelines shall be conducted in accordance with the relevant rules and regulations of the Ministry of Education and of the University.
- Article 6 The aforementioned guidelines shall be implemented and entered into force upon approval by a meeting of the Institutional Affairs Committee and appraisal and ratification by a meeting of the Academic Affairs Committee. The same procedure applies to any amendment of these guidelines.
