

Course Credit Waiver Guidelines for Students in the Graduate Institute of Philosophy at National Central University

Approved at the Institutional Affairs Committee Meeting on September 11, 2001
Approved at the Academic Affairs Committee Meeting on October 11, 2001

- Article 1 These guidelines are provided in accordance with the *National Central University Credit Waiver Guidelines*.
- Article 2 Students who have taken relevant graduate courses offered by other universities or by National Central University within five years of their admission into the Graduate Institute of Philosophy [hereinafter referred to as “the Institute”] and have passed such courses with a grade of no less than 70 points may apply for a course credit waiver; in such case, applications are restricted to courses which have not previously been counted toward the student’s minimum graduation requirements for a degree. Applications for course credit waivers must be filed within the deadline as specified in the academic calendar during the students’ first semester at the University; students may not apply more than once.
- Article 3 All applications for course credit waivers must be reviewed by the Institute and subsequently approved at a general meeting of the Institute faculty before being put into effect.
- Article 4 The maximum number of course credit hours that can be waived is 12.
- Article 5 The aforementioned guidelines shall be implemented and entered into force upon approval by a meeting of the Institutional Affairs Committee and appraisal and ratification by a meeting of the Academic Affairs Committee. The same procedure applies to any amendment of these guidelines.
