

Guidelines for Students Enrolling in the Non-Degree

Conferring Program in RFID Logistics and Supply Chains

1. This interdepartmental non-degree conferring program is designed to integrate the insights of business management with the capabilities of Radio Frequency Identification (RFID) Systems in the interest of cultivating professionals who can meet the need for industrial digitalization.
2. Students studying in any college or department in the University may apply for entry into this program, but students with knowledge of business management will be given priority.
3. University students who comply with these guidelines and earn the necessary credit hours (21 or more) shall have the name of the program as well as the number of credit hours earned clearly indicated on their transcript and shall also be awarded a certificate of completion.
4. The non-degree-conferring program is divided into Basic Course, Core Course, and Advanced Courses, as shown by the Table of Course Offerings below.
5. Whether courses taken in other RFID programs may be accepted in lieu of courses offered by this program shall be left to the discretion of the ERP Center; if the Center is unsure whether to grant the waiver, the decision shall be deferred to the ERP Curriculum Committee.
6. These guidelines shall be implemented and entered into force upon approval by a meeting of the Academic Affairs Committee. The same procedure applies to any amendment of these guidelines.
