

Guidelines for Students Enrolling in the Non-Degree Conferring Program in Creativity

1. The aim of this program is to develop and enhance the student's creative potential and to foster creative thinking and creative habits that will prove beneficial in professional and daily life.
2. The enrollment criteria are as follows:
 - A. Any University student may apply for entry into this program.
 - B. Those seeking to enroll in this program must have their application approved by the Office of Creativity Development Research before submitting the application to the head of the Center for General Education for initial approval and the Dean of Academic Affairs for final approval.
 - C. A minimum of 20 credit hours are required to earn a certificate of completion.
3. University students who comply with these guidelines and earn 20 or more course credit hours from the program curriculum shall have the name of the program as well as the number of credit hours earned clearly indicated on their transcript and shall also be awarded a certificate of completion.

4. The course requirements for this program are as follows:
 - I. Six or more credit hours from the following three required course areas:
 - i. Special Topics in Creativity: Creativity and Creative Design (GS4713).
 - ii. Creative Theory: either Creativity Theory and Technique (GS3901) or Critical and Creative Thinking (GS2601).
 - iii. Creative Practice: either Creative People (GS2620) or Ideals and Practices of Creativity and Multiple Intelligences (GS3902).
 - II. Ten or more credit hours of elective courses in two or more of the following course areas (this includes courses taken at other institutions via the interuniversity course selection option):
 - i. Literature and the Arts
 - ii. Multimedia and Information
 - iii. Education and Management
 - iv. Science and Technology
5. Whether courses with similar titles and content taken in other programs offered by the four institutions participating in the University System of Taiwan can be accepted in lieu of courses offered by this program shall be decided by the Center for General Education, which shall base its decision on the rules set forth in the University's *Course Credit Waiver Guidelines*.
6. These guidelines shall be implemented and entered into force upon approval by a meeting of the Academic Affairs Committee. The same procedure applies to any amendment of these guidelines.
