- Article 1 These guidelines are provided in accordance with the *National Central University Credit* Waiver Guidelines.
- Article 2 Course credit waiver stipulations for electrical engineering majors:

Required courses offered by the Department and courses marked with an asterisk (*) cannot be waived with courses taken from other universities or other departments at National Central University. Where the number of credit hours earned from courses taken outside the Department exceed the number of credit hours the student seeks to waive, those offered by the Department shall prevail.

- Articles 3 Students applying for a course credit waiver shall submit a duplicate copy of their application form to the Department to be kept for future reference.
- Article 4 The aforementioned guidelines shall be implemented and entered into force upon approval by a meeting of the Departmental Affairs Committee and appraisal and ratification by a meeting of the Academic Affairs Committee. The same procedure applies to any amendment of these guidelines.
