

# **National Central University Regulations on Subsidies for Departments and Institutes Offering Courses to Students from Other Departments**

Amended and approved at the NCU Academic Affairs Meeting on June 20, 2018  
Amended and approved at the NCU Academic Affairs Meeting on March 19, 2025

## Article 1

The National Central University (hereinafter referred to as NCU) Regulations on Subsidies for Departments and Institutes Offering Courses to Students from Other Departments (hereinafter referred to as the Regulations) are established to encourage each department / graduate institute to increase the number of students who take a double major, who take a minor, and who pursue a bachelor's degree in interdisciplinary studies to take courses provided by each department / graduate institute.

## Article 2

The students from other departments referred to in the Regulations include students who take a double major, who take a minor, and who pursue a bachelor's degree in interdisciplinary studies.

## Article 3

The subsidies shall be granted in accordance with the Regulations. The subsidies are based on the number of credits taken by students from other departments and are given to the departments / graduate institutes that accept such students.

To encourage departments and graduate institutes to offer specialized module courses, a one-time incentive of up to NT\$20,000 shall be granted for each module upon approval by the University Curriculum Committee.

## Article 4

The subsidy shall be calculated by the Curriculum Division based on the number of cross-departmental course enrollments for the semester and directly allocated to each

department or graduate institute.

#### Article 5

##### Funding Sources:

The funding shall come from the University's self-financing revenue and other government subsidies. In the event of insufficient funds, the subsidy amount shall be adjusted accordingly.

#### Article 6

These regulations shall take effect upon approval by the Academic Affairs Committee, and the same procedure shall apply to any amendments.
